LENTEN REGULATIONS

ABSTINENCE (meat) Binds all those 14 years and older on all Fridays of Lent. (It is not strictly required for Holy Saturday, although it is strongly recommended wherever possible).

FASTING (Limiting oneself to ONE full meal for the day) Binds those between the ages of 18 and 59 for Good Friday and recommended where possible on Holy Saturday.
