St. Gregory VII Patron Saint of musicians, singers, students and teachers Feast Day: May 25




Gregory VII, who was baptized Hildebrand, began his religious life at the Santa Maria monastery in Rome and later entered the service of Archpriest John Gratian. When Gratian was named to the papacy as Gregory VI, Hildebrand became his chaplain. Pope Gregory was forced into exile in 1046, and Hildebrand accompanied him to Cologne, where he remained until the pontiff's death the following year.

In 1049, Hildebrand was again thrust into the Church hierarchy when Pope Leo IX named him cardinal-subdeacon. In this post, Hildebrand carried out a series of reforms, known as "The Gregorian Reform," to renew the mission of the Church and to establish the papacy as the ultimate authority of Church doctrine.

Hildebrand focused on establishing the sovereignty of the Church by ending the influence of regional rulers on Church offices. He also demanded adherence to a stricter code of conduct among the clergy and created safeguards to ensure that Church revenues remained within the Church.

Although offered the papacy several times, Hildebrand consistently declined, preferring instead to serve a succession of popes. It was not until 1073, following the death of Alexander II, that he reluctantly accepted election as Pope Gregory VII, a title chosen to honor the memory of his early mentor. Gregory's papacy was not without struggle, however. Most notable is his conflict with Emperor henry IV who ultimately invaded Rome, installed an antipope, and forced Gregory into exile in Salerno, where he died a short time later.


