

Knights of Columbus Breakfast after Masses



The patriarch of Western monasticism was born at Nursia, in central Italy, about 480. In his youth, seeing the corruption of the world, he left home to live a hermit's life of penance and prayer in a cave in the mountain of Subiaco, near Rome, where he was instructed in Christian asceticism by St. Romanus, a solitary of the vicinity.

His reputation for sanctity gathered a large number of disciples around him, for whom he erected monasteries in which the lived a community life under prescribed rule. In the year 529, he left Subiaco for Monte Cassino, and there founded the great Abbey which became the center of religious life in Europe.

The principles of the Rule written by St. Benedict became the basis of religious life for all Western religious orders and congregations after his time. It shows the way to religious perfection by the practice of self-conquest, mortification, humility, obedience, prayer, silence, retirement, and detachment from the world and its cares.

St Scholastica, the sister of St. Benedict, was the first Benedictine nun. She presided over a monastery of nuns near Monte Cassino. St. Benedict died March 21, 543, as he stood before the altar at Monte Cassino immediately after receiving Holy Communion.

The Brown Scapular **Our Lady of Mount** Carmel

Our Lady of Mount Carmel is a title given to the Blessed Virgin Mary in her role as the "Patroness of the Carmelite Order". The first Carmelites were Christian hermits living on Mt. Carmel in the Holy Land. On July 16, 1251, Our Lady appeared to Saint Simon Stock, a Carmelite, and made the Scapular the sign of her protection.

Celebrate the Feast

Participate in a daily Novena (9 days). Copies of the Novena are on the tables in the back of the church. The Novena begins on Sunday, July 7th and ends on Monday, July 15th.

Scapular Investitures will be at the weekend mases July 13th and 14th and on the feast day, Tuesday July 16th.

Investiture is a ceremony where honors are formally conferred on a particular person,

Saint Bonaventure Feast Day—July 15 Bishop & Doctor of the Church

St. Bonaventure, widely known as "The Seraphic Doctor." was born at Bagnorea in Tuscany, in 1221. He was originally called John but received the name of Bonaventure in Consequence of an exclamation of St. Francis of Assisi, when, in response to the pleading of the child's mother, the Saint prayed for John's recovery from a dangerous illness, and foreseeing the future greatness of the little John, cried out, "O buona ventura" - O good fortune!

At the age of twenty-two St. Bonaventure entered the Franciscan Order. Having made his vows, he was sent to Paris to complete his studies under the celebrated doctor Alexander of Hales, an Englishman and a Franciscan. After the latter's death he continued his course under his successor, John of Rochelle. In Paris he became the intimate friend of the great St. Thomas Aquinas. He received the degree of Doctor, together with St. Thomas Aquinas, ceding to his friend, against the latter's inclination, the honor of having it first conferred upon him. Like St. Thomas, he enjoyed the friendship of the holy King, St. Louis.

At the age of thirty-five he was chosen General of his Order and restored a perfect calm where peace had been disturbed by internal dissensions. He did much for his Order and composed the life of St. Francis. He also assisted at the translation of the relics of St. Anthony of Padua. He was nominated Archbishop of York by Pope Clement IV, but he begged not to be forced to accept that dignity. Gregory X obliged him to take upon himself a greater one, that of Cardinal and Bishop of Albano, one of the six suffragan Sees of Rome. Before his death he abdicated his office of General of the Franciscan Order. He died while he was assisting at the Second Council of Lyons, on July 15, 1274, and was canonized in 1482 by Pope Sixtus IV.
