
For any events that are coming up, please give enough notice to the bulletin editor to get it in the bulletin and on our website.



St. Rose of Lima, Virgin Feast Day—August 23 Patroness of South America Isabel De Flores Y Del Oliva, called Rose by her mother because of her red cheeks and confirmed with that name by St. Turibius de Mogrovejo, was the first person in the Ameri-cas to be canonized as a Saint Born at Lima cas to be canonized as a Saint. Born at Lima, Peru, in 1586, she worked long and hard to help support her family, growing flowers and doing embroidery and other needlework.

Having taken a vow of virginity early in b life, she consistently refused to marry and at 💋 twenty years of age became a Dominican Ter- 💋 💆 tiary, and lived in a summerhouse in the gar- 💆 den of her home. Here she practiced extreme penance and mortification, modeling her life

St. Rose bore her many and great adversities with heroic patience and consoled the sick 🗖 and suffering among the poor, Indians, and 🗖 Slaves. Consequently, she is regarded as the slaves. Consequently, she is regarded as the originator of social service in Peru. She died of in 1617 at thirty-one years of age and was canonized in 1671 by Pope clement X. In today's world, where beauty seems to one mean so much, the story of St. Rose is just as of relevant as it was when she was canonized

O.C.I.A. is a time of formation and guidance aimed at training the participants in the Christian life leading to the reception of the sacraments of initiation which are baptism, confirmation, and communion.


