## 2025 COLLECTION ENVELOPES ARE OUT!!!!





#### St. John Paul II, Pope

A native of Wadowice, Poland, Karol Wojtyla became Pope John Paul II in 1978. Among his many accomplishments as pope, he made 104 apostolic journeys outside Italy and promulgated a new catechism. He inaugurated World Youth Day and the World Meeting of Families. John Paul II dies on April 2, 2005. "It is Jesus that you seek when you dream of happiness," he told young people in the year 2000. "He is waiting for you when nothing else you find satisfies you; he is the beauty to which you are so attracted... It is he who reads in your hearts your most genuine choices that others try to stifle."



### St. Anthony Mary Claret, Bishop

Anthony Mary Claret was ordained in 1835 and served as apostolic missionary to his native Catalonia and the Canary Islands, Archbishop of Santiago, Cuba, and confessor to Queen Isabella II. Only five feet tall, Anthony astounded many with the power of his preaching. He is said to have given over ten thousand sermons in his lifetime, sometimes preaching six or seven in a day. When asked how he could continue, he replied, "I am just a horn; someone else does the blowing." The order he founded, the Claretians, continues to spread the Gospel through a thriving publishing apostolate.
