

Miraculous Medal Annual Enrollment

Every year our parish participates in the Annual Enrollment of the Miraculous Medal from November 14th to November 30th.

Those wishing to participate in the Novena (9 days) to the Miraculous Mary, may obtain a Novena Card in the back of the church on the table.

Novena begins on Nov. 18th & ends on Nov. 26th.



Annual Enrollment Book

Anyone may enroll in the Association of the Miraculous Medal, including yourself, any age, for any living or deceased person (s), Catholics or non Catholics. The enrollment book and all donations are sent to the Association of the Miraculous Medal after Christmas. You may enroll from Nov. 14 to Nov. 30.

The Blessed Mother appeared to (now), St. Catherine Labore, and on Nov. 27, 1830, she revealed to her the design of the medal and the prayer "O Mary conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to thee!" St. Catherine's Feast day is November 28th.

Learn more about the medal of the Immaculate Conception, popularly known as the miraculous medal, designed by the Blessed Virgin herself. Blessed Medals, Novena Cards, and Brochures will be available on the table in the back of the church.

St. Rose Philippine Duchesne Virgin November 18 Patron Saint of perseverance & adversity

Born in Grenoble, France, in 1769, Rose joined the Society of the Sacred Heart. In 1818, when she was forty-nine, Rose was sent to the united States. She founded a boarding school for daughters of pioneers near St. Louis and opened the first free school west of the Missouri.

At the age of seventy-one, she began a school for Indians, who soon came to call her "the woman who is always praying." Her biographers have also stressed her courage in frontier conditions, her singlemindedness in pursuing her dream of serving Native Americans, and her self—acceptance.

The holy servant of God was beatified in 1940 by Pope Pius XII and canonized in 1988 by Pope St. John Paul II.




