## Discover the Mystery of the Shroud of Turin

Join us for a captivating exploration of the Shroud of Turin with Deacon Paul as we delve into pivotal questions: Who is the man on the Shroud? How was his image transferred to this ancient burial cloth? Why do the bloodstains on the Shroud and the Sudarium of Oviedo (face cloth) match, yet only the Shroud bears a mysterious image?

Explore these and other intriguing aspects from the “Who is the Man on the Shroud?” exhibition, hosted by the Faith and Science Institute at the Pontifical Museum in Rose. This virtual video tour promises an enlightening experience with enlarged images, a life-size bronzed 3D sculpture, and replicas of the historical artifacts associated with the crucifixion, including the Roman flagrum (whip), crown of thorns, nails of crucifixion, and more.

## **Presentation of the Lord**

The second day in February is the feast of the Presentation of the Child Jesus in the Temple, which is also called the feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin. Another name for this popular feast is Candlemas Day.

Forty days after His birth, Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the Temple of Jerusalem to present Him to the Lord as the law of Moses prescribed. They carried with them the usual offering of the poor, a pair of turtledoves. The law of Moses commanded that the first-born male child should be offered to God in thanksgiving for the sparing by the exterminating Angel, of the Israelites in Egypt.

The law also prescribed that on the fortieth day after the birth of her child a mother should offer a sacrifice of purification from legal stain: namely, a lamb and a young pigeon, or, should she be poor, a pair of young pigeons or turtledoves.

At the time of the presentation and purification there was in the Temple a just and God-fearing man named Simeon, who recognized the infant Messiah, and taking Him in his arms declared Him the Savior, the Light of the Gentiles and the Glory of Israel.

On this feast candles are blessed and carried in procession with appropriate prayers and ceremonies. The blessed beeswax candles typify the humanity which God the Son assumed, and signify that Jesus Christ is the True Light of the world by His doctrine, grace, and example. They also represent the ardent faith, hope, and charity with which the Christian should follow Christ by humble obedience to His Gospel and imitation of His virtues.

Blessed candles are lighted at Mass and other church services; at the administration of all the Sacraments except Penance; in imparting blessings, in processions, and in other liturgical ceremonies. There should be at least two blessed candles in every Catholic home for use when the Sacraments are administered to the sick, and at times of any special danger, blessing, or family devotion.

Getting to Know our Winter Priests....

### **Father Michael Wensing**

Birthday: May 29th

**Anniversary of Ordination: June 3, 1976**

Home State: South Dakota

Fr. Mike was ordained in 1976. After ordination, while serving at a local parish, he taught in the local Catholic high school in Sioux Falls, SD. The bishop then assigned him as vocations director and youth office director for the diocese. In that assignment, he wrote his first book "Ministry to Youth". After that, he was asked to go to Rome to get his advanced degree in Scripture. In 1985, he obtained his License degree and was appointed the Newman chaplain at USD, while also teaching at Mount Marty, a Catholic College. During that time, his second book was published.

In 1989, he became pastor of St. Michael in Sioux Falls with a mandate to build a Catholic School. After 10 years, he was assigned to be professor of Old & New Testament at the seminary, Mt. St. Mary's. Years later, he was called to become pastor in Brookings, SD. The new bishop then assigned him to the Pontifical North American Seminary in Rome. His final parish assignments were in his native town of Watertown for the last ten years of active ministry. In retirement, he moved to Sioux Falls.

He was friends with Fr. Rodney, who talked fondly of St. George, so in 2022, when invited to assist at St. George, he was glad to help. He returned again in 2024 & 2025.

In retirement Fr. Mike has written two more books. His most recent book, "Death and Afterlife in the Bible and the Church: Developing Traditions in History and our Final Hope" can be found on Amazon.com. Also, limited quantities of that book will be available to purchase at the parish office for \$11.99.


