CONFIRMATION 2027



Confirmation will take place in the Spring of 2027. Confirmation Candidates will be in at least 10th grade during the spring of 2027 and have received the Sacrament of First Eucharist. Students wanting to be Confirmed will have had **2 continuous years of religious education.** i.e. students must have been registered and attending Life Teen (or Sacrament Prep Class) during the 2025/2026 as well as the 2026/2027 religious education year.

O.C.I.A. (Order of Christian Initiation for Adults-formerly R.C.I.A.)

O.C.I.A. is the process for adults to inquire and learn about the Roman Catholic Church. It is designed to assist each individual in their faith journey, and to help them discern where the Holy Spirit is leading them.

O.C.I.A. is for those not baptized who desire to respond to God's invitation. It is also for those already baptized, but not in the Catholic Church or for those who were baptized in the Catholic Church but have not received Holy Communion or been Confirmed.

It is also for members of the parish who have a desire to deepen their own spirituality by involving themselves through the process of sponsorship of an O.C.I.A. candidate.

The Brown Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel

Our Lady of Mt. Carmel is the title given to the Blessed Virgin Mary in her role as the "Patroness of the Carmelite Order." The first Carmelites were Christian hermits (having a strong Marian devotion) living on Mt. Carmel in the Holy Land. On July 16, 1251, Our Lady appeared to Saint Simon Stock, a Carmelite and made the Scapular the sign of her protection.

The promotion of the Scapular & Consecration to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel will be at the 8:00 a.m. morning mass on Wednesday, July 16th.



St. Camillus De Lellis, Priest Feast Day—July 14 Patron of Hospitals and the sick

St. Camillus was born in 1550, in a small town of the Kingdom of Naples. In his youth he became a soldier and for some time led a wayward life. He lost so much in gaming that he was forced to work as a laborer on a building belonging to the Capuchins. An exhortation made to him by the guardian of the convent touched him by the guardian of the convent touched him and he resolved to change his conduct.

He now begged to be admitted into the Order, but Divine Providence willed otherwise. Twice he received the Capuchin habit, but he was obliged each time to leave the novitiate, as he could not be admitted to profession on account of an ulcer on one of his legs. He later went to Rome and entered the Hospital of Incurables, and after some time was appointed its administrator. Regarding himself as the servant of the sick, he renedered them the most humiliating services.

At the age of thirty-two he undertook to study, beginning the first elements of grammar with the children. Having been ordained priest, he laid the foundation of the Congregation of Regular Clerics to administer to the sick. He had obstacles to encounter, but he triumphed over them all and succeeded in obtaining from the Apostolic See the approbation of his Institute.

Henceforth his life was entirely devoted to the sick and the dying, and after his death this work was continued by the Order he had founded. The Saint had as confessor another Saint, namely, Philip Neri, the founder of the Oratory, who preceded him to the tomb. St. Camillus was endowed by God with the spirit of prophecy and other supernatural gifts. He died on July 14, 1614, and was canonized in 1746 by Pope Benedict XIV.
